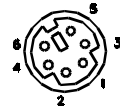
PROGRAMMING THE KEYBOARD

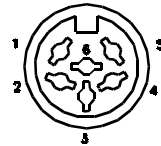

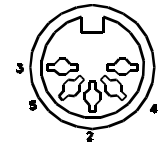

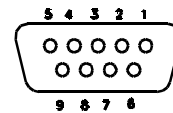

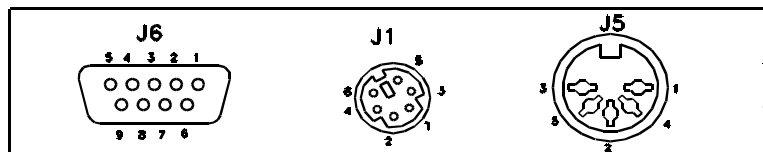
